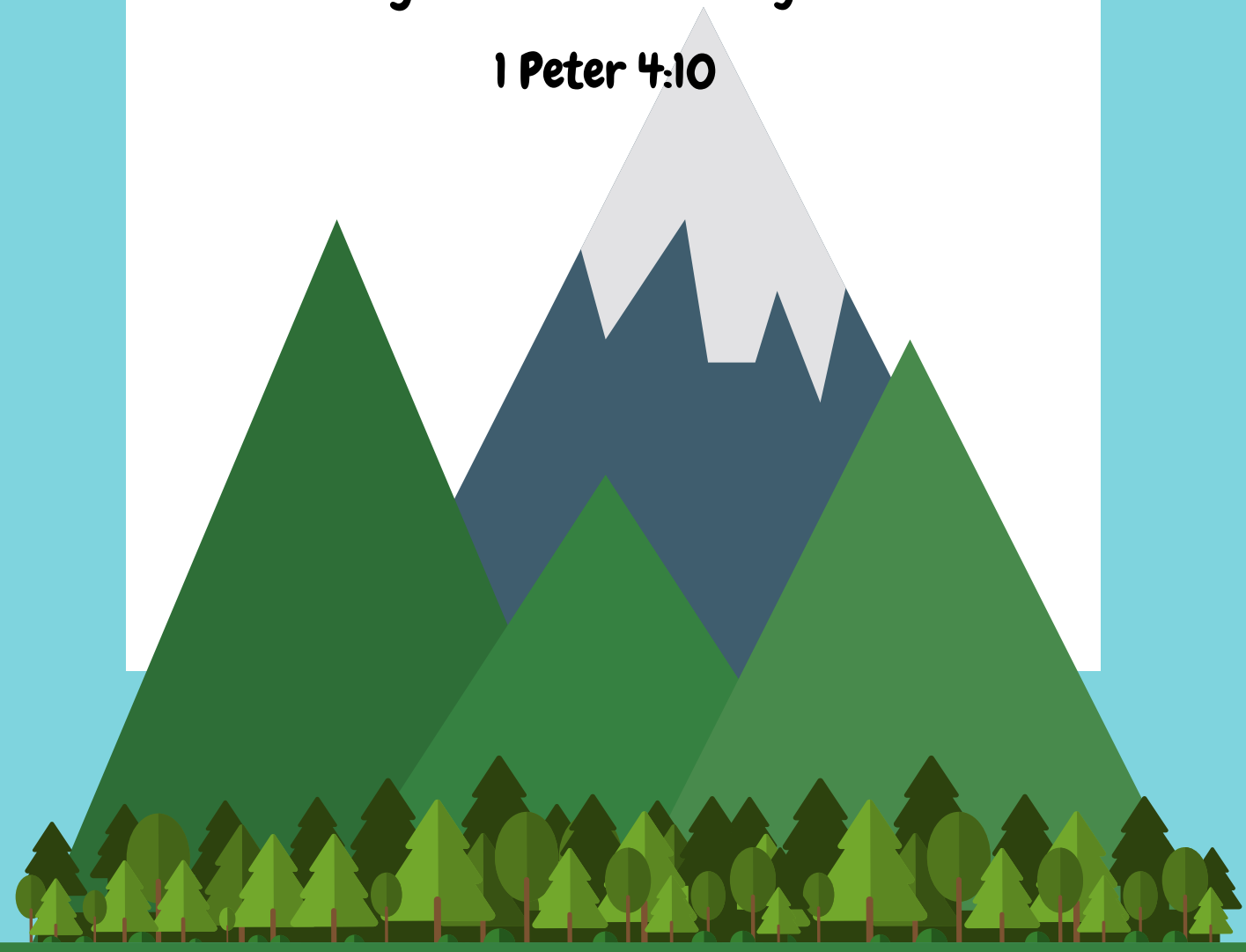




TEAM VOLUNTEER HANDBOOK

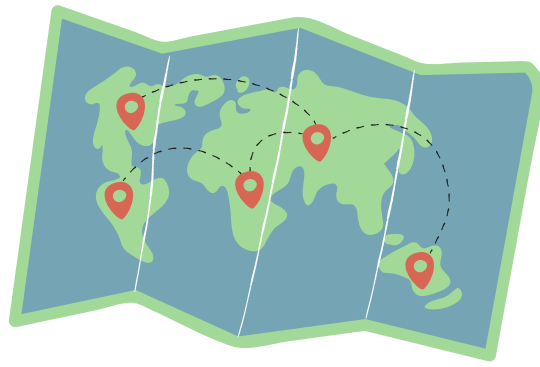

13. If an injury occurs while the child is under your care, contact DK Director and fill out an incident report.
14. Any inappropriate behavior (students or leaders) must be reported to DK Director and/or leadership.
15. Check name tags before releasing child to parent to make sure stickers match (also making sure they have one on when they enter the room).
16. Attend meetings and orientations when available.
17. Agree to Submit to the Authority of the church leadership.
18. Every Dk area has a Group Me. This will be where we communicate lessons, schedules, and any other needs. (Please engage and check them regularly)
19. Background checks will be updated Yearly (January)
20. Represent Jesus and the church in proper manner in relationships, lifestyle choices, sexuality, character, and integrity.
21. Pursue healing and growth in every area of your life. (Discipleship track is a great place to start)

Serve Opportunities

DK Team Lead

- You will be in charge of the room and the flow of the morning.
- Read lesson prior to service and come prepared.
- Arrive early and make sure everything is ready on Sunday morning.
- Greet parents at the door, introduce yourself, smile, and make child feel welcome.
- Teach lesson with creativity and engagement.
- Communicate needs to kids directors. (Includes Behavior, Supplies, Snacks)
- Delegate tasks to assistant / helpers.
- Use classroom management appropriately.
- Clean up room and make sure everything is ready for next service.
- Stay until next team member shows up.

DK Team Assistant

- You will be the lead teacher's Assistant in helping with crafts, snacks, games, and anything else needed.
- Arrive 20 minutes before service
- Engage and play with children.
- Pray over the children be sensitive to their needs.
- Assist and take children to the restroom.
- Help clean up at end of service.
- Redirect kids behavior and help with classroom management.
- Stay until next team member shows up.
- (Elementary) Small Groups, Reward Dots, Monthly Character

DK Team Helper (Youth 6th+)

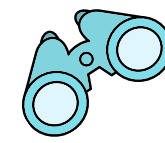
- Your responsibility is to help and assist wherever needed.
- Be teachable, have good attitude, be responsible, and helpful.
- Arrive 20 minutes before service.
- Engage and play with children.
- Help clean up at the end of service.

DK Team Junior (5th+)

- This will be chosen based off Directors observation of behavior, participation, and leadership exhibited in Elementary each Sunday.
- Be teachable.
- Be engaged.
- Be willing to grow and be mentored.

Elementary Media Team

- Willing and able to run audio and visual (proresenter) on Sunday mornings.
- Be attentive and not distracted.
- Arrive Early



DK Team Expectations

1. Arrive 20 minutes before service.
2. Wear your DK t-shirt and appropriate dress attire.
3. Have your name tag sticker printed out and visible.
4. If you can't be there for some reason contact director in advance and help find someone to replace you if possible.
5. Have a good attitude, smile on your face, put aside distractions and give 100%.
6. Try to eat and get a drink before entering the classroom.
7. Two team members need to be in room at all times (We understand this isn't always possible, try to do your best)
8. If a child needs to be accompanied to the restroom, stand outside the door and make sure they are ok.
9. Changing diapers should only be done by a female adult (follow safety precautions).
10. Help recruit and encourage others to serve. (Grab a friend to serve with) Apply at DLC.tv/DestinyKids tab
11. Use appropriate touch and safety towards children in your care.
12. In the event of an emergency, call a DK Director, Grab an Elder/Deacon, if it's life threatening call 911.
